L48 <i>Sukashitrocos atkinsoni</i> (1877) Shoreham Beach, Westernport, Vic L49 <i>Cantharidella tiberiana</i> (Crosse, 1863) Shoreham, Westernport, Vic. Woods named it <i>Gibbula aurea</i> in 1876? Earlier name has precedence. L50 <i>Leucotina casta</i> (A Adams, 1853) Woods named it <i>Fossarus bulimoides</i> in 1877. Earlier name has precedence. L51 <i>Benthoxystus petterdi</i> (Crosse, 1870) Woods named it <i>Trophon clathratus</i> in 1876. Earlier name has precedence. L52 <i>Eulima augur</i> (Angas 1865) Woods named it <i>Eulima apheles</i> in 1879. Earlier name has precedence. L53 <i>Merelina hulliana</i> (Tate, 1893) Point Leo, Westernport, Vic. Formerly known as <i>Dunkeria fasciata</i> (Woods 1876) L54 <i>Munditia subquadrata</i> (1878) Shoreham, Westernport Bay, Vic L55 <i>Austromitra analogical</i> (Reeve, 1845) Point Leo, Westernport, Vic. Woods named it <i>Mitra legrandi</i> in 1876. Earlier name has precedence. L56 <i>Conus rutilus</i> (Menke, 1843) Point Leo, Westernport, Vic. Woods named it <i>Conus macleayana</i> in 1877. Earlier name has precedence. L57 <i>Eulima tenisoni</i> (Tryon, 1886) Shoreham, Westernport Bay, Vic. Woods had named it <i>Eulima micans</i> in 1876, but name pre-occupied. Tryon renamed it for Woods. L58 <i>Epicodakia minima</i> (1875, Shoreham Beach, Westernport, Vic L59 <i>Zafra fulgida</i> (Reeve, 1859) San Remo, Westernport Bay, Vic. Woods named it <i>Columbella minuta</i> in 1876. Earlier name has precedence. L60 <i>Macroschisma tasmaniae</i> (Sowerby, 1869) Point Leo, Westernport, Vic. Woods named it <i>Macroschisma rosearadiata tasmaniae</i>. Earlier name has precedence. L61 <i>Odostomia suprasculpta</i> (1878) Point Leo, Westernport, Vic.</p>

L65 *Cingulina spina* (Crosse & Fischer, 1864) San Remo Westernport Bay, Vic. Woods named it *Aclis tristriata* in 1877. Earlier name has precedence.

L66 *Mitrella (Dentimitrella) Pulla* (Gaskoin, 1851) San Remo Back Beach, Vic. Woods named it *Columbella dictua* in 1879. Earlier name has precedence.

L67 *Tellina (Macamona) margaritina* (Lamarck, 1818) San Remo Back Beach, Vic. Woods named it *Tellina mariae* in 1876. Earlier name has precedence

Recent (Living) Marine [RM] Species

RM68 *Diala suturalis* (A Adams, 1853) Limeburner's Lagoon, Corio, Vic. *Diala punctata* (Woods 1876). Earlier name has precedence.

RM69 *Hydrococcus braziere* (Woods 1876) Alcoa Wharf, Point Henry, Port Phillip, Vic [Recent Marine]

RM70 *Assiminea tasmanica* (1876) Watson's Creek, Westernport Bay, Vic. In mangroves. [See G16]

RM71 *Ascorhis tasmanica* (Martens, 1858) Lake Connewarre, Leopold, Vic. *Bythinia victoriae* (Woods, 1878). Earlier name has precedence.

RM72 *Truncatella scalarina* Cox, 1863. Limeburner's Lagoon, Corio, Vic. Mudflats. *Truncatella tasmanica* (Woods 1876/77). Earlier name has precedence
